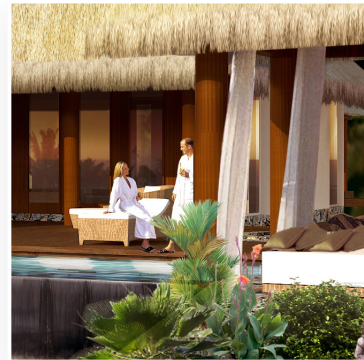
A Forgotten Paradies, Reimagined

Tucked away on 96 hectares of pristine beauty, this **lush tropical haven reimagines contemporary design with the raw, untouched splendor of nature and traditional Fiji architecture.** From densely forested hills and spring-fed streams to a former coconut plantation that gently slopes toward 800 meters of powder-white sand beach, the setting feels like a world long lost—**serene, soulful, and deeply authentic.**

Whether you arrive by seaplane landing directly in front, by boat to the private yacht harbor, or via a short flight from the island’s airport, you’re instantly enveloped in a tranquil atmosphere defined by both its **unspoiled landscape and the genuine warmth of its people.**

The thoughtfully crafted resort includes a five-star boutique hotel featuring 50 private bures (villas), two oceanfront restaurants and bars, a spa nestled beside a tranquil lagoon, a dive center, fitness studio, small conference facility, market plaza, entertainment lawn, and a 12-slip private marina. For those seeking permanent escape, 64 expansive villa lots are available for private ownership.
